LCS developed the visitor center exhibit for this national estuary on the New Jersey shore – the most pristine estuarine habitat in the NE Coastal region of the United States. The exhibition, housed at the maritime history center Tuckerton Seaport, focuses on the Reserve’s marine ecosystems, stretching from the Pinelands to the Atlantic Ocean, and on Rutgers University’s research programs here. It teaches visitors about the estuary without compromising its actual fragile ecology. LCS is responsible for the interpretive development, exhibit design and fabrication, collaborating with Partners in Design (exhibit graphic design) and TPN (fabrication).
