Snoqualmie Falls is the second most visited tourist destination in Washington state. But most people do not recognize the fact that there is a historic underground hydroelectric plant with a tale of engineering intrigue or that the Snoqualmie Tribe considers the Falls as the place of Creation. Puget Sound Energy hired Lehrman Cameron Studio to interpret these tales and make them visible throughout the Park. The first phase (Upper Park, shown here) was completed in 2010. The rest of the Park, including Lower Park and Trail, and Plant One Historic District are also part of the LCS scope.
