LCS developed an interpretive and educational plan for the Washington state parks that border the Puget Sound. The intent is to describe the work that the Parks is doing to improve the storm water and wastewater systems under the Governor's Puget Sound Initiative project. Our plan suggests a baseline approach at all parks to include signage, programs, and other techniques to be employed across all parks along with special projects such as sculpture, playgrounds, guided trails, rain garden amphitheatres, and other ambitious projects at particular locations. All methods are site and context-specific and are intended to maximize a connection for the public to help people understand what the WA Parks is doing and what they can do in their communities to improve water conditions throughout the state.
